

# Sanctuary wins landscaping award

Applied Ecological Services Inc. announced that The Sanctuary of Bull Valley, a residential conservation development in Woodstock, received a 2005 Conservation and Native Landscaping Award from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and Chicago Wilderness. Jack Porter & Associates Inc., also of Woodstock, developed the subdivision and contracted with AES for restoration planning, design and installation services on more than 100 acres of open space at the 200-acre

site. AES created a natural area landscape plan, an alternative stormwater management plan and installed native seed, plants, shrubs and trees from Taylor Creek Restoration Nurseries, a division of AES.

The award recognizes The Sanctuary of Bull Valley for outstanding efforts to use native plants within the Chicago Wilderness region.
