



Amended Sign Standards

Only one, two-foot by three-foot (maximum size), approved real estate sign is permitted on each lot. During construction, one additional two-foot by three-foot sign may be placed to identify the builder, lender, or owner, and to post required building permits. All real estate and construction signs must conform to Association specifications

Other than realtor signs, all signs should be similar in design – With white background and dark green (PMS 3435) trim. All Signs should be mounted on a white 4”x4” post with dark green trim. Contact ARB for questions or approval of custom signs.



Temporary garage sale signs, open house signs, etc. are allowed, but must be removed each night and not be present for more than four consecutive days. All signs that do not meet the standards including subcontractor signs, will be removed at the expense of the owner or agent. Permit must be posted below the sign.
